1. Restore the fertile places and the ability to produce.
2. Release finances and favor

C. The valley of Achor for a door of hope

1. Achor means place of trouble, trials, & devastation.
2. Problems, Difficulties, Dilemma, Mess, Nuisance, Snag, Danger, Hitch
3. It is the valley where Achan and his family and possessions were stoned to death for disobeying God.

David said, Yea though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil.

D. God said, "I will bring back the joy and strength of your youth.

1. We will have reason to smile, rejoice.
2. God will add to our strength the ability to do what He has planned for our lives.

3. We will give ourselves to God through worship and praise by singing.
4. If you are in trouble, God said, "I want you to sing to me."

(Rom 9:25 KJV) As he saith also in O see, I will call them my people, which were not my people; and her beloved, which was not beloved.

(Rom 9:26 KJV) And it shall come to pass, that in the place where it was said unto them, Ye are not my people; there shall they be called the children of the living God.
