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(John 4:37 NKJV) "For in this the saying is true: 'One sows and another reaps.'

(John 4:38 NKJV) "I sent you to reap that for which you have not labored; others have labored, and you have entered into their labors."

Sermon Title: A Rendezvous With Harvest

1. I believe the Bible describes at least 4 types of harvest

A. Personal harvest

1. What you and I have personally sown in faith.
2. Whatever a man soweth that shall he also reap.
3. Give and it shall be given you good measure

B. Corporate harvest

1. What we sow as a people or church
2. Nations sow and reap
3. Families sow and reap

C. Generational harvest

1. Blessings of our forefathers who died without reaping.
2. God never forgets a seed. If it was planted, God wants to give the harvest.

D. God's harvest

1. The salvation of souls Jesus died for.
2. The punishment of the wicked.
3. The end of the world
4. A new heaven and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness.

2. Today I want to talk about Generational Harvest.

Note: Jesus is Lord of the Harvest. He has appointed you as a reaper to enter into the labor of others and reap where you have not sown.

We have been chosen to be reapers in these last days. We need both sowing faith and **reaping faith!!**

I believe that it is possible for all four harvests that I mentioned could run concurrent.

3. Jesus as Lord of the harvest is directing the harvest even as Boaz who was the Lord of the Harvest and a type of Christ

- . **A.** Handfuls on purpose
- B.** The restoration of the inheritance and blessings of her dead husband
- C. Her position as the bride of Boaz the Lord of the Harvest**

4. Harvest time is a time of rejoicing. We need faith to rejoice. God has set up a Rendezvous with harvest. We have a harvest appointment.

5. A Windfall Harvest. A restoration of inheritances not reaped by the past generations.

- A.** A bonus
- B.** A boon
- C.** A gusher

6. We have a need to connect to the past

Example: **Elijah** passed his mantle to Elisha and Elisha took the ministry to a double portion level. **Elisha never** passed his mantle. And in 2 Kings 13:20-21 dead man touching Elisha's bones and coming alive from the anointing still in his bones.

7. The un-reaped harvest of the body of Christ who sowed and sowed and never reaped will come forth as a great harvest in God's harvest season.

Point: If we can repent for the sins of our fathers and break the curse that resulted in their sins off the land, and the church, could we not by faith release the anointings and blessings that were taken to the grave, but God has kept in seed form until the last days.

8. Part of the promise of God to Israel is that they would live in houses they did not build; eat from fields they did not plant

9. In Gen. 26:18 Isaac re-digs to the wells of his father and renamed them what Abraham has named them.

(Gen 26:18) And Isaac digged again the wells of water, which they had digged in the days of Abraham his father; for the Philistines had stopped them after the death of Abraham: and he called their names after the names by which his father had called them.

10. A Rendezvous with Harvest

- A.** People that are ready to be saved. Someone else has done the work of planting and watering and God is going to give you the increase.
- B.** Divine favor that has been help back because of lack of understanding and knowledge in your family
- C.** Anointings and giftings in ministry and faith for miracles
- D.** Financial release from the spirit of containment.

We have been assigned to reap! You will live in houses you did not build! Eat from vineyards you did not plant!
