Introduction: The standard by which all Old Testament writers used to describe the power and greatness of God was the Exodus of Israel from Egypt. In almost every book of the Bible you will find references to how God brought Israel out of bondage and established them as a nation. King David makes it the theme of many of his psalms. The Apostle Peter and the Apostle Paul refers to this event in the New Testament. Jesus Himself connects this event with communion when He kept the Passover with His disciples. The Passover of course begin with the deliverance of Israel from Egypt.

If they were discouraged, they remembered how God had brought them out. When they needed a reason to shout and dance, they used the Exodus as a way to bring life to the party. To the Israelite it was the greatest thing that God had ever done for them.

Here in the book of Isaiah chapter 43 God Himself reminds Israel of this event and says,

(Isa 43:13 NLT) "From eternity to eternity I am God. No one can oppose what I do. No one can reverse my actions."
